


FROM CAPITALISM

01 RACISM

Discrimination based on race, upholding inequality and systemic power imbalance

02 WHITE SUPREMACY

The belief in white dominance, perpetuating racial inequities and colonial legacies.

03 HIERARCHY

Social strata that privilege some groups over others, legitimizing dominance.

04 INDIVIDUAL OVER COMMUNITY

Prioritizing personal gain over collective well-being, often fueling competition.

05 ENVIRONMENTAL TERRORISM

Deliberate or reckless destruction of ecosystems, often tied to corporate or political interests.

06 MAN DESTROYS NATURE

Expansion of power through domination, subjugating peoples and resources abroad.






