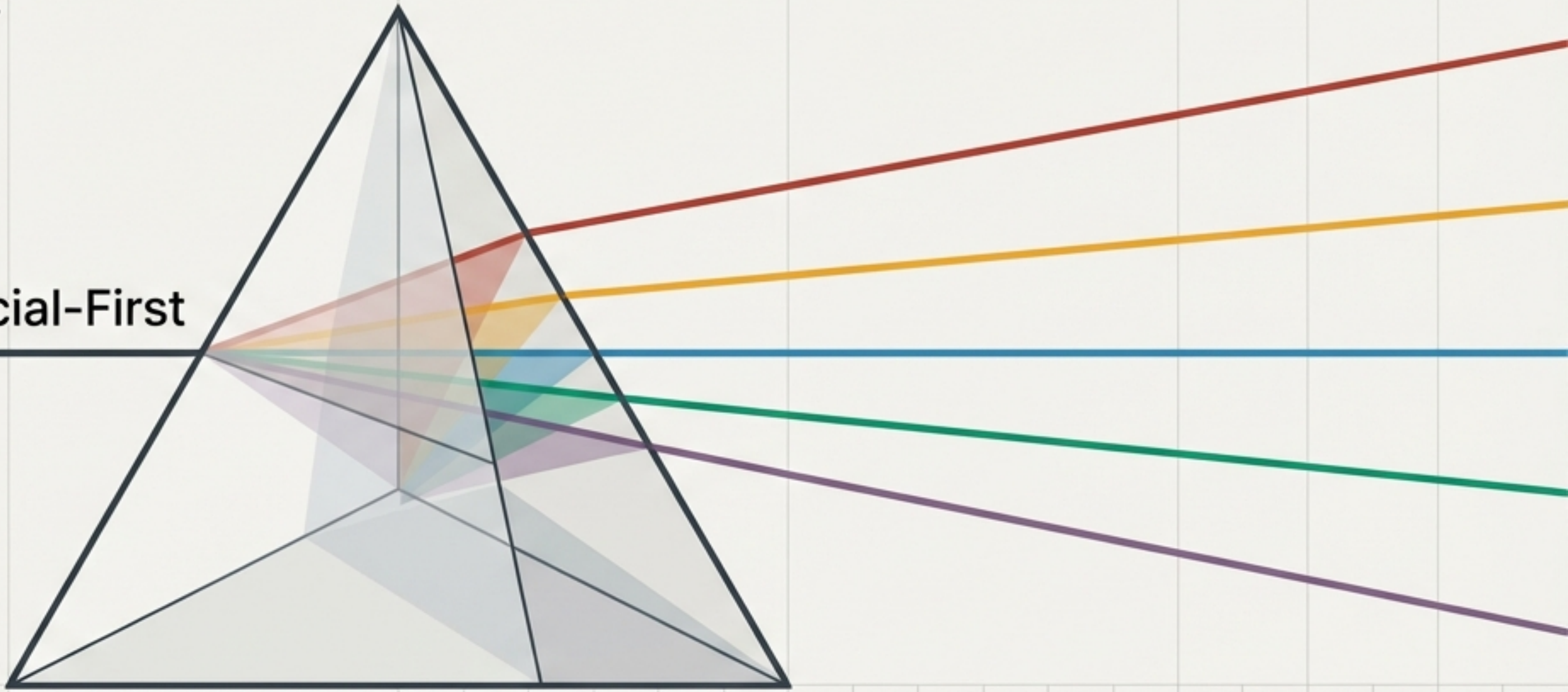


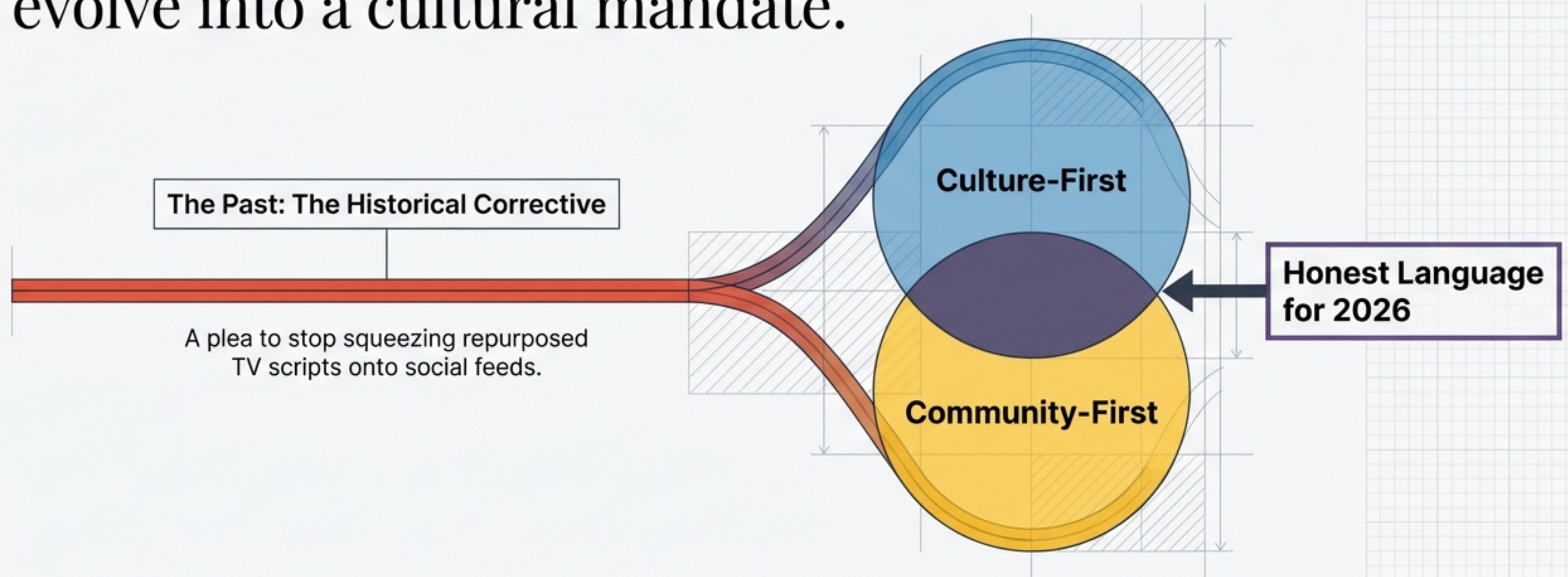

Social-First



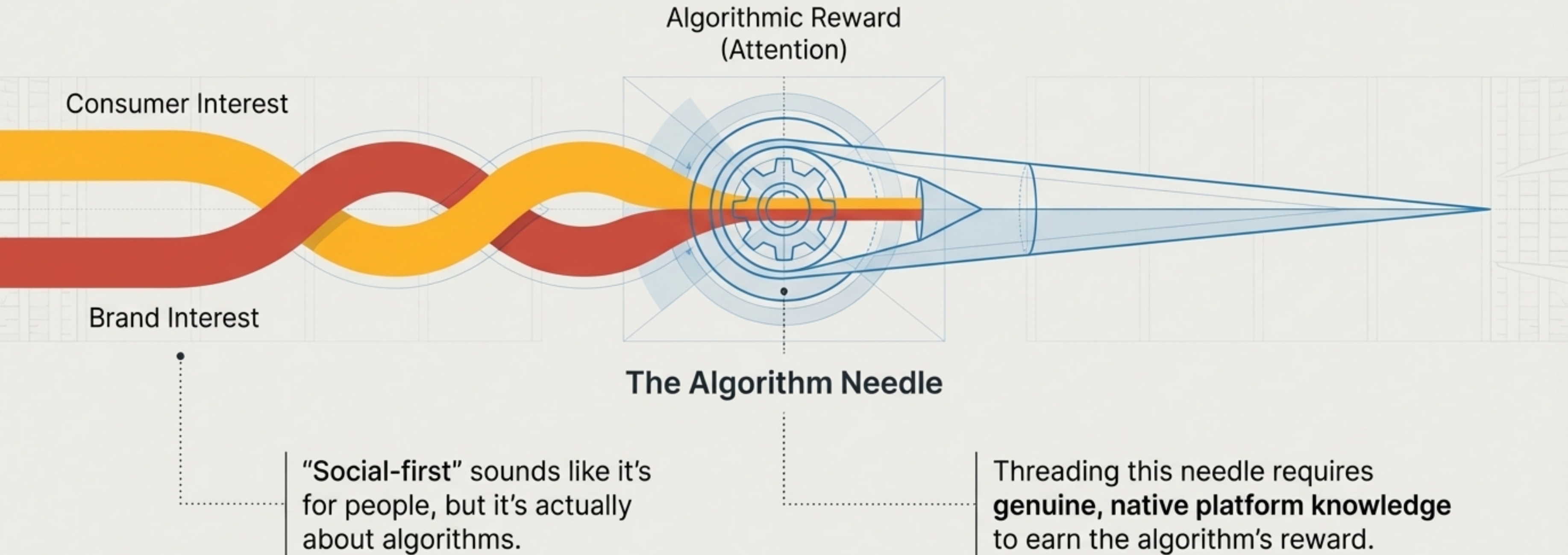
Moving beyond vertical video formats to build a multi-dimensional framework for algorithm, culture, and campaign architecture.

A historical rallying cry must evolve into a cultural mandate.

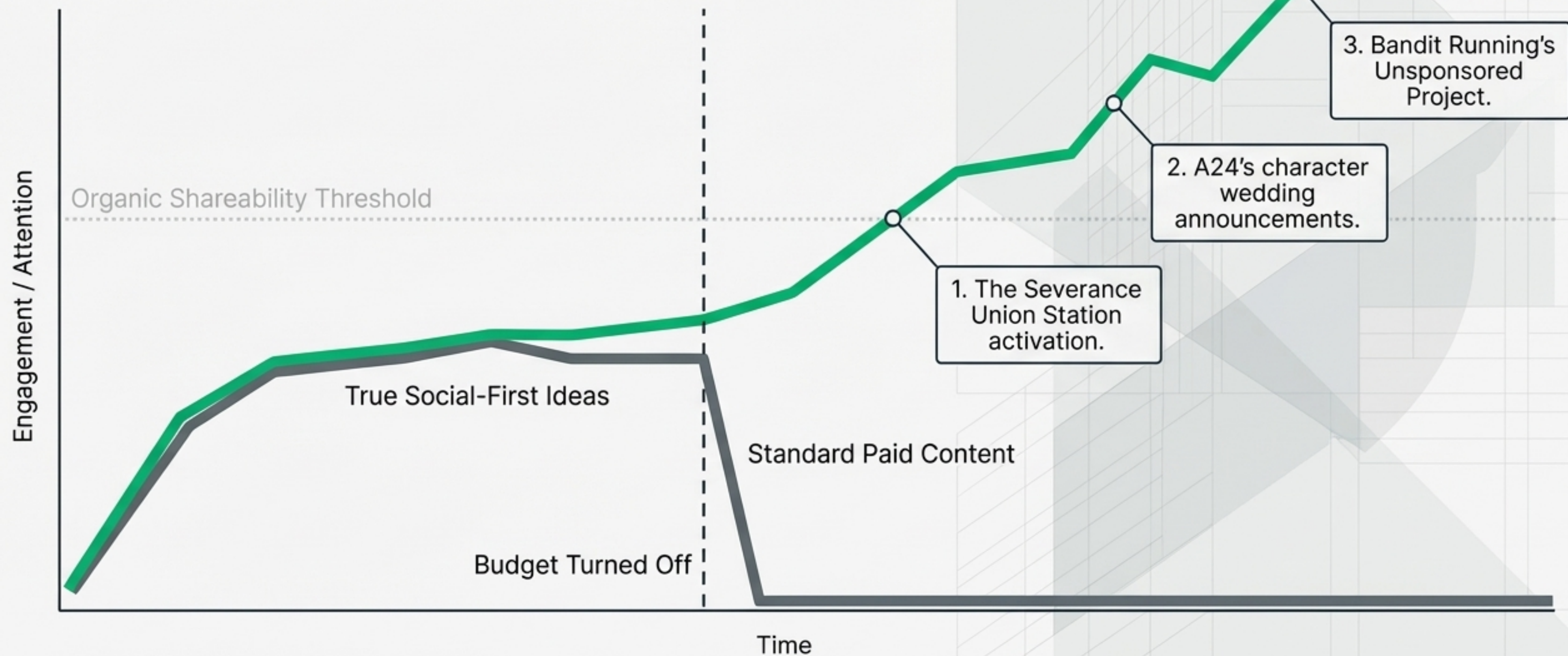


If we are honest, 'social-first' today actually means culture-first or community-first.

Unpaid engagement is the ultimate litmus test for relevance.

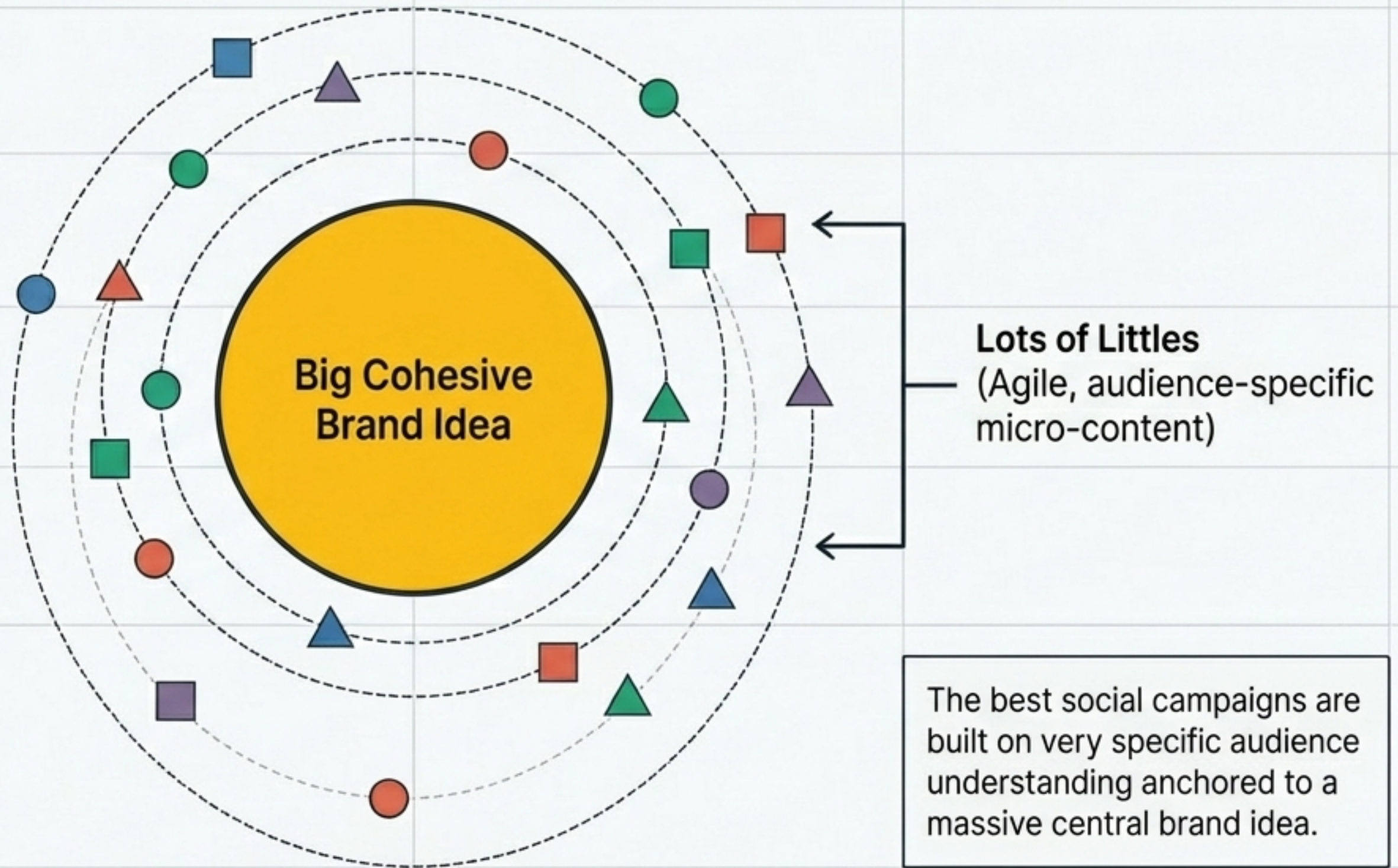


Vertical format is a baseline, not a platform strategy.

Audience Mindset	Entertainment, immersive discovery, audio-driven.	Information seeking, algorithmic rabbit holes.	Aesthetic curation, close-network sharing.
Consumption Behavior	Endless swipe, high active engagement.	Search-driven surfacing, long-tail viewership.	Passive feed blending, direct message sharing.

Social-first must go far deeper than the 9:16 aspect ratio. Identical formatting does not equal identical behavior.

Modern campaigns require central gravity and agile orbits.



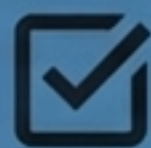
The 2026 Social-First Scorecard



1. The Culture Test: Is this community-first, or just a repurposed TV script?



2. The Algorithm Test: Does this thread the needle of consumer interest, brand interest, and algorithmic reward?



3. The Threshold Test: Would users actively choose to engage with this if the paid media budget was zero?



4. The Platform Test: Is the strategy tailored to distinct consumption behaviors, or just lazily formatted in 9:16?



5. The Architecture Test: Is there a cohesive core brand idea supported by an orbit of audience-specific "littles"?

TRUE SOCIAL-FIRST MARKETING REQUIRES PASSING ALL FIVE TESTS SIMULTANEOUSLY.
