A – Aspirations

Imagine the Philippines—not just known as the largest Christian nation in Asia—

but as a launchpad of missionaries, innovators, and servant-leaders bringing Jesus to the hardest places on earth.

Picture a nation where:

- Students discover purpose and live out generosity.
- Churches unite under one mission.
- Movements rise from slums to boardrooms.

P – Problems

Right now, potential is trapped by limitation.

1. Spiritual Dryness – Faith is being preserved instead of passed forward. Many churches are strong in attendance, but weak in deployment.
2. Limited Influence – Few believers are equipped to lead in key areas like technology, business, or media.
3. Capacity Gaps – Our current base can't house or train enough missionaries to meet the need.

If we stay here, we risk turning a living movement into a museum of memories.

If nothing changes:

- A new generation will inherit Christianity without mission.
- Filipino believers will remain spectators instead of ambassadors.
- The opportunity to send laborers into the 10/40 Window may pass by.

The cost isn't just organizational—it's eternal.

A nation called to send will remain stuck receiving.
